Piglet gets trapped by a flood and gets rescued by Pooh and Christopher Robin

#### **Write to Piglet**

This chapter begins with Piglet becoming increasingly concerned as water rises around him. Stop after page 133's first paragraph and talk about Piglet's feelings. Then ask children to write a letter to Piglet offering him advice on what he should do.

#### **What Could You Use to Float?**

The animals in the Wood cleverly create floating devices out of everyday things. Ask your children to delve into their creative minds to come up with something in the classroom they could try to float in during a flood. Have children use their imaginations and create drawings of their floatation devices to post around the room.
