Tying It All Together

Enjoy this last chapter together cozily as a class reading it purely for it's warm and loving conclusion. Then choose from the following closing activities to complete your unit.

Picking a Pooh Favorite

Ask children to think about all of the Pooh friends to whom they've come to know. Then ask them to write a letter to Pooh telling him which one of the characters they enjoy the most. Encourage them to use descriptive language from the lists you've created and posted. They should give examples from the stories you've shared to further explain.

Which Pooh Friend Are You?

Ask children to think about which Pooh friend they are most like and explain why in their journals.

Write a Pooh Poem

Ask children to write a poem, either traditional or acrostic telling everyone about a Pooh adventure or character.

Sing a Pooh Song

In groups, have children use the tune of a favorite song to write their own creation about Winnie the Pooh. Once children have written and practiced their song, they can share it with the class.

Make a Pooh Puppet Show

Have the children retell their favorite Pooh story in writing. Then allow them to create puppets that correspond to the characters in their story. Once they have practiced their show, encourage them to share it with the class.
